- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of
- 2 corrections and rehabilitation; to provide for a report; to provide an exemption; and to declare an
- 3 emergency.

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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the department of corrections and rehabilitation for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department of corrections and rehabilitation, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

21	the 2023-25 biennium. The department of corrections and rehabilitation shall report to the			
22	appropriations committees of the sixty-eighth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time			
23	funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.			
24	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - 2019-21 BIENNIUM - FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS			
25	RELIEF FUND - SPENDING RESTRICTION. There is appropriated out of any moneys from			
26	federal funds derived from the federal coronavirus relief fund, not otherwise appropriated, the			
27	sum of \$43,689,050, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of			
28	corrections and rehabilitation for law enforcement payroll costs, for the period beginning March			
29	2020 and ending June 2021. The funding appropriated in this section replaces existing			
30	legislative appropriations. The department of corrections and rehabilitation may not spend the			

1 funding appropriated from the general fund for law enforcement payroll costs during the period 2 identified. 3 SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND. The 4 estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$18,371,718, or so much 5 of the sum as may be necessary, from the federal coronavirus relief fund for law enforcement 6 payroll costs for the period beginning July 1, 2021, and ending December 31, 2021. 7 SECTION 5. COMMUNITY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAM - PAYER OF LAST 8 **RESORT.** The department of corrections and rehabilitation must be considered the payer of last 9 resort whenever any other benefit or source of third-party payment, excluding the substance 10 use disorder treatment voucher program, is available for community-based behavioral health 11 services for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. The funding 12 appropriated to the department of corrections and rehabilitation for community-based behavioral 13 health services must be utilized prior to utilizing substance use disorder treatment voucher 14 program funding. 15 SECTION 6. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION OPERATING 16 FUND REVENUES. Any moneys received by the department of corrections and rehabilitation 17 from correctional supervision, electronic monitoring, and detention; reimbursements from other 18 agencies; profits received from department of corrections and rehabilitation commissary; 19 miscellaneous revenue, including offender fines, fees, restitution, and medical copayments; and 20 from the youth correctional center permanent fund, may be deposited in the department of 21 corrections and rehabilitation operating fund and expended pursuant to legislative appropriation 22 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. 23 SECTION 7. EXEMPTION - COMMUNITY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAM. The 24 amount of \$7,000,000 from the general fund appropriated for the community behavioral health 25 program in section 1 of chapter 15 of the 2019 Session Laws is not subject to section 26 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from this appropriation may be used for the community 27 behavioral health program during the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 28 2023. 29 SECTION 8. EXEMPTION - DEFERRED MAINTENANCE AND EXTRAORDINARY 30 **REPAIRS.** Notwithstanding any amount continued under section 4 of this Act, up to \$6,000,000 31 from the general fund appropriated to the department of corrections and rehabilitation in

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- 1 section 1 of chapter 15 of the 2019 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11, and any
- 2 unexpended funds from this appropriation may be used for deferred maintenance and
- 3 extraordinary repairs projects by the department of corrections and rehabilitation during the
- 4 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.
- 5 **SECTION 9. EMERGENCY.** Section 3 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
