4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the information technology department for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the information technology department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021,

3	SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - 2019-21 BIENNIUM LEGACY FUND EARNINGS -
4	CYBERSECURITY. It is the intent of the sixty-seventh legislative assembly that the
5	\$16,547,033 appropriated from the general fund for cybersecurity initiatives in section 1 of this
6	Act be derived from 2019-21 biennium legacy fund earnings, of which \$4,824,465 is in the
7	salaries and wages line item, \$11,591,534 is in the operating expenses line item, and \$131,034
8	is in the capital assets line item.
