- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 34-06-22 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the state minimum wage rate.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 34-06-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **34-06-22. State minimum wage rate.**
- 7 1. Except as otherwise provided under this chapter and rules adopted by the commissioner, every employer shall pay to each of the employer's employees:
- 9 a. Effective July 24, 2007 August 1, 2021, a wage of at least fivenine dollars and eighty-five cents per hour;
- b. Effective July 24, 2008 August 1, 2022, a wage of at least sixten dollars and
  fifty-five cents per hour; and
- c. Effective July 24, 2009 August 1, 2023, a wage of at least seven eleven dollars
  and twenty-five cents per hour;
- 15 <u>d.</u> <u>Effective August 1, 2024, a wage of at least twelve dollars per hour;</u>
- 16 <u>e. Effective August 1, 2025, a wage of at least thirteen dollars per hour;</u>
- 17 <u>f. Effective August 1, 2026, a wage of at least fourteen dollars per hour; and</u>
- 18 g. Effective August 1, 2027, a wage of at least fifteen dollars per hour.
- This section does not limit the authority of the commissioner to adopt rules
  establishing aexceptions to the state minimum wage rate that differs which differ from
  the rates established under subsection 1.
