- 4 providing reduced tuition and fee charges in North Dakota institutions of higher education for
- 5 dependents of disabled veterans; and to provide an appropriation.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-10-18.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is 8 amended and reenacted as follows: 9 15-10-18.2. 3	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 15-10-18.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
4	amended and reenacted as follows:

6	- Any dependent, as defined in section 15-10-18.2, upon being duly accepted for enrollment			
7	into any undergraduate degree or certificate program of a North Dakota state institution of			
8	higher education, must be allowed to obtain a bachelor's degree or certificate of completion, for			
9	so long as the dependent is eligible, free of any tuition and fee charges if the bachelor's degree-			
10	or certificate of completion is earned within a forty-five-month or ten-semester period or its-			
11	equivalent and if tuition and fee charges do not include costs for aviation flight charges or			
12	expenses. Once an individual qualifies as a dependent under sections 15-10-18.2 and			
13	15-10-18.3 satisfies the requirements of this section, the dependent may not be disqualified from			
14	the benefits of this section:

16	- 2. Due to the return of the individual missing in action; or

21	SECTION 1. Section 15-10-18.6 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted			
22	as follows:			
23	15-10-18.6. Reduced tuition in North Dakota institutions of higher education.			
24	1. As used in this section:			
25	a. "Dependent" means a child, stepchild, spouse, widow, or widower of a resident			
26	veteran, as "veteran" is defined in section 37-01-40, who:			
27	(1) Has a service-connected disability rating of at least fifty percent but no more			
28	than ninety-nine percent, as determined by the department of veterans'			
29	affairs; or			
30	(2) Has an extra-schedular rating to include individual unemployability that			
31	brings the veteran's total disability rating to at least fifty percent but not more

1		than ninety-nine percent, as determined by the department of veterans'	
2	affairs.		
3		b. "Resident veteran" has the same meaning as provided under section 15-10-18.2.	
4	2.	Any dependent upon being duly accepted for enrollment into any undergraduate	
5		degree or certificate program of a North Dakota state institution of higher education is	
6		entitled to obtain a bachelor's degree or certificate of completion, for so long as the	
7		dependent is eligible, at reduced tuition and fee charges provided the bachelor's	
8		degree or certificate of completion is earned within a forty-five-month or ten-semester	
9		period or its equivalent. For purposes of this section, tuition and fee charges do not	
10		include costs for aviation flight charges or expenses.	
11	3.	A dependent is entitled to the following reduction in tuition and fees under	
12		subsection 2:	
13		a. A fifty percent reduction if the resident veteran has a service-connected disability	
14		rating of at least fifty percent but not more than fifty-nine percent;	
15		b. A sixty percent reduction if the resident veteran has a service-connected disability	
16		rating of at least sixty percent but not more than sixty-nine percent;	
17		c. A seventy percent reduction if the resident veteran has a service-connected	
18		disability rating of at least seventy percent but not more than seventy-nine	
19		percent;	
20		d. An eighty percent reduction if the resident veteran has a service-connected	
21		disability rating of at least eighty percent but not more than eighty-nine percent;	
22		<u>or</u>	
23		e. Ninety percent reduction if the resident veteran has a service-connected disability	
24		rating of at least ninety percent but not more than ninety-nine percent.	
25	SE	CTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general	
26	fund in	the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$3,800,000, or so much of the	
27	sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of providing		
28	reduced tuition and fees to a dependent of a disabled resident veteran, for the biennium		
29	beginni	ng July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.
