- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-17-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **12.1-17-01. Simple assault.**
- 7 1. A person is guilty of an offense if that person:
 - a. Willfully causes bodily injury to another human being; or
 - b. Negligently causes bodily injury to another human being by means of a firearm, destructive device, or other weapon, the use of which against a human being is likely to cause death or serious bodily injury.

- a. A class C felony when:
 - (1) When the victim is a peace officer or correctional institution employee acting in an official capacity, which the actor knows to be a fact; an employee of the state hospital acting in the course and scope of employment, which the actor knows to be a fact, and the actor is an individual committed to or detained at the state hospital pursuant to chapter 25-03.3; a personan individual engaged in a judicial proceeding; or a member of a municipal or volunteer fire department or emergency medical services personnel unit or emergency department worker in the performance of the member's duties:
 - (2) If the victim is employed or contracted by a health care facility, which the actor knows to be a fact, and the assault occurs on the health care facility
