- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study relating to the behavioral health
- 2 needs of inmates.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH NEEDS OF
- 5 **INMATES.** During the 2021-22 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the
- 6 behavioral health needs of incarcerated adults. The study must consider the behavioral health
- 7 needs of incarcerated adults, including access, availability, and delivery of services. The study
- 8 also must include input from stakeholders, including representatives of law enforcement, social
- 9 and clinical service providers, educators, medical providers, mental health advocacy
- organizations, emergency medical service providers, tribal government, state and local
- 11 agencies and institutions, and family members. The legislative management shall report its
- 12 findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the
- 13 recommendations, to the sixty-eighth legislative assembly.
