1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision e of subsection 2 of section 38-08-04.5 and

2 subdivision b of subsection 1 of section 57-51-15 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to

3 the abandoned oil and gas well plugging and site reclamation fund; and to provide an effective4 date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision e of subsection 2 of section 38-08-04.5 of the
7 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

8	e. Rec	clamation and restoration of land and water resources impacted by oil and gas
9	dev	elopment, including related pipelines and facilities that were abandoned or
10	wer	e left in an inadequate reclamation status before August 1, 1983, and for
11	whie	ch there is not any continuing reclamation responsibility under state law. Land
12	and	water degraded by any willful act of the current or any former surface owner
13	are	not eligible for reclamation or restoration. The commission may expend up to
14	five	thirty-five million dollars per biennium from the fund in the following priority:
15	(1)	For the restoration of eligible land and water that are degraded by the
16		adverse effects of oil and gas development including related pipelines and
17		facilities.
18	(2)	For the development of publicly owned land adversely affected by oil and
19		gas development including related pipelines and facilities.
20	(3)	For administrative expenses and cost in developing an abandoned site
21		reclamation plan and the program.
22	(4)	Demonstration projects for the development of reclamation and water
23		quality control program methods and techniques for oil and gas
24		development, including related pipelines and facilities.

1	SECTION	2. AMENDMENT. Subdivision b of subsection 1 of section 57-51-15 of the North
2	Dakota Centu	ry Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
3	b.	Four percent of the amount available under this subsection to the abandoned oil
4		and gas well plugging and site reclamation fund, but not in an amount exceeding
5		seven <u>fifteen</u> million five hundred thousand dollars per fiscal year and not in an
6		amount that would bring the balance in the fund to more than fiftyone hundred
7		<u>fifty</u> million dollars.
8	SECTION	I 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 2 of this Act becomes effective for taxable events

9 after June 30, 2021.
