- 6 to repeal section 50-24.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to medical assistance
- 7 remedial eye care.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 9 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 50-24.1-26 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 11 50-24.1-26. Medicaid waivers In-home services.
 - The department shall administer Medicaid waivers to provide in-home services to children with extraordinary medical needs and to children up to the age of <u>fourteensixteen</u> diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder who would otherwise meet institutional level of care. The department may prioritize applicants for the waiver for children with extraordinary medical needs by degree of need.
- 17 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 50-24.1-32 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 50-24.1-32. Medical assistance Services provided by physician assistants and advanced <u>practice</u> registered <u>nurse practitioners nurses</u>.
 - The medical assistance program must recognize physician assistants and advanced practice registered nurse practitioners with the roles of nurse practitioner or certified nurse midwife as primary care providers with the same rights and responsibilities given primary care physicians under the medical assistance program. Any care provided by the physician

- 1 assistant or advanced <u>practice</u> registered <u>nurse practitioner</u>nurse with the roles of nurse
- 2 <u>practitioner or certified nurse midwife</u> as a primary care provider under the medical assistance
- 3 program must be within the scope of the physician assistant's or advanced <u>practice</u> registered
- 4 <u>nurse practitioner's nurse's</u> respective license.
- 5 **SECTION 3.** A new section to chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 6 and enacted as follows:
- 7 <u>Automated clearing house payments to medical assistance providers and provider</u>
- 8 applicants.
- The department shall provide payment to medical assistance providers and may provide
- 10 payments to provider applicants using an automated clearing house to provide for electronic
- 11 <u>fund transfers. To receive payment, medical assistance providers and provider applicants shall</u>
- 12 provide sufficient documentation to enable the department to provide electronic funds transfers
- 13 through an automated clearing house. No other forms of payment are permitted.
- 14 **SECTION 4. REPEAL.** Section 50-24.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
