# FIRST ENGROSSMENT

#### **ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2089**

Introduced by

(At the request of the Department of Human Services)

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 17 of section 50-06-05.1 of the North

- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to financing of welfare programs and housing stabilization
- 3 supports and rental assistance; to repeal sections 1-02-35 and 50-06-14 of the North Dakota

4 Century Code, relating to obsolete effective date language and financing of welfare programs;

- 5 to provide a statement of legislative intent; to provide for a legislative management study; and to
- 6 declare an emergency.

#### 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 17 of section 50-06-05.1 of the North Dakota

9 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

10 17. To administer, allocate, and distribute any funds made available for the making of

11 direct cash assistance payments, housing assistance payments stabilization supports,

- 12 and rental subsidies under any rental assistance programs initiated by the federal-
- 13 government not otherwise by law made the responsibility of another state agency-

14 possessing statewide jurisdictionand to promote cooperation and working agreements

- 15 with public agencies and including the housing finance agency and department of
- 16 <u>commerce, and private human services agencies</u>.

SECTION 2. REPEAL. Sections 1-02-35 and 50-06-14 of the North Dakota Century Codeare repealed.

## 19 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER VOUCHER

20 **PROGRAM.** The department of human services shall adopt rules to seek additional flexibility for

21 the administration of the autism spectrum disorder voucher program to ensure families can be

- 22 served within available appropriations. The administrative code changes should consider
- 23 changes that include reducing the amount of approved voucher funds available to each
- 24 household and the amount of time during which a household may use approved voucher funds.

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- 1 The department of human services shall request the legislative assembly to fund the autism
- 2 spectrum disorder voucher program with three hundred thousand dollars.

# 3 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER

### 4 WAIVER AND VOUCHER PROGRAMS AND TASK FORCE. During the 2021-22 interim, the

- 5 legislative management shall consider studying the autism spectrum disorder waiver and
- 6 voucher programs and other programs designed to provide services to children who are
- 7 impacted by autism spectrum disorder and the elimination of the autism spectrum disorder task
- 8 force. The study may include consideration of the structure of the programs and whether there
- 9 are any gaps and unmet needs. The legislative management shall report its finding and
- 10 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 11 the sixty-eighth legislative assembly.

12 **SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
