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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state

6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and

other income, to the veterans' home for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the veterans'

8 home, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025, as follows:

13	SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME - SOLDIERS' HOME FUND - ADMINISTRATOR			
14	HOUSING STIPEND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum			
15	of \$48,000 from the soldiers' home fund for the purpose of providing a \$2,000 monthly housing			
16	stipend to the veterans' home administrator for housing costs off the veterans' home campus.			
17	SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS			
18	FUND - PARKING LOT AND ROAD REPAIRS - ONE-TIME FUNDING. The estimated income			
19	line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$600,000 from the strategic investment and			
20	improvements fund for the purpose of repairing parking lots and roads on the veterans' home			
21	campus. This funding is considered a one-time funding item.			
22	SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - FEDERAL STATE FISCAL RECOVERY FUND -			
23	THERMOSTAT REPLACEMENTS - ONE-TIME FUNDING. The estimated income line item in			

section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$328,930 from federal funds derived from the state

fiscal recovery fund for the purpose of a thermostat and air handling unit replacement project.
