- 1 A BILL to provide for a legislative management study relating to the effects of required
- 2 curriculum on accreditation and related constitutional issues.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY EFFECTS OF PROHIBITING
- 5 SPECIFIED CONTENT IN ACADEMIC CURRICULUM OR TRAINING. During the 2023-24
- 6 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the effects of prohibiting specified
- 7 content in academic curriculum or in the training of students or school employees. The study
- 8 must include possible effects on the accreditation status of North Dakota's eleven institutions of
- 9 higher education. The study also must examine potential conflicts between such prohibitions
- 10 and the United States Constitution and article VIII of the Constitution of North Dakota, including
- 11 the constitutional authority of the state board of higher education. The legislative management
- shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to
- implement the recommendations, to the sixty-ninth legislative assembly.
