- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 11-11 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 40-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to cooperative purchasing pursuant to
- 3 a joint powers agreement; and to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 11-11-14, and
- 4 subsection 52 of section 40-05-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to authorizing a
- 5 city or a county to engage in cooperative purchasing.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 4 of section 11-11-14 of the North Dakota Century
- 8 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- To control the finances, to contract debts and borrow money, to make payments of
 debts and expenses, to establish charges for any county or other services, and to
 control the property of the county, and to contract for cooperative purchases pursuant
 to a joint-powers agreement under chapter 54-40.3.
- 13 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 11-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 15 <u>Cooperative purchasing Authorized.</u>
- With the approval of the board of county commissioners, a county may participate in
- 17 cooperative purchasing agreements with the state or another political subdivision by executing
- 18 <u>a joint-powers agreement under chapter 54-40.3. A county also may participate in cooperative</u>
- 19 purchasing programs established by any organization that offers its goods or services as a
- 20 <u>result of competitive solicitation processes. Approval from the office of management and budget</u>
- 21 <u>under section 54-44.4-13 is not required for a cooperative purchasing agreement executed</u>
- 22 under this section.
- 23 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 52 of section 40-05-01 of the North Dakota
- 24 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
