- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a dual special needs plan for Medicaid; and to provide an
- 3 appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 Dual special needs plan.
- 8 By January 1, 2025, the department shall implement at least one dual special needs plan
- 9 for Medicare and Medicaid dual-eligible Medicaid recipients. The department shall establish
- 10 standards for care coordination services the dual special needs plan must provide to recipients.
- 11 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES -
- 12 DUAL SPECIAL NEEDS PLAN. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
- the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$356,269\$237,516, or so much of the
- sum as may be necessary, to the department of health and human services for the purpose of
- funding <u>a full-time</u> equivalent <u>positions</u> to implement the Medicaid dual special needs
- plan, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025. The department is
- authorized one and one-half full-time equivalent positions position to coordinate the planning
- and implementation of the Medicaid dual special needs plan.
