## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE - FEDERAL STATE
FISCAL RECOVERY FUND - ONE-TIME FUNDING. There is appropriated from federal funds
derived from the state fiscal recovery fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of
\$2,000,000\(\frac{\$3,000,000}{},\) or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of
commerce for the purpose of providing a grant to an organization that provides grants to
organizations that provide recovery and support services for individuals with a substance use
disorder, other mental health disorder, or combination of disorders, for the biennium beginning
July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025. The department of commerce shall collaborate with the
department of health and human services to establish guidelines to provide grants under this
section. This funding is considered a one-time funding item. To be eligible to receive a grant
under this section, an organization must have provided peer support services to individuals with
a substance use disorder, including those served through the federal Medicaid 1915(i) state
plan amendment, during the calendar year ending on December 31, 2022.
