- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for a grant for substance use disorder and mental
- 2 health recovery services.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE - FEDERAL STATE 5 FISCAL RECOVERY FUND - ONE-TIME FUNDING. There is appropriated from federal funds 6 derived from the state fiscal recovery fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$3,000,000, 7 or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the purpose of 8 providing grants to organizations that provide recovery and support services for individuals with 9 a substance use disorder, other mental health disorder, or combination of disorders, for the 10 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025. The department of commerce shall 11 collaborate with the department of health and human services to establish guidelines to provide 12 grants under this section. This funding is considered a one-time funding item. To be eligible to 13 receive a grant under this section, an organization must have provided peer support services to 14 individuals with a substance use disorder, including those served through the federal Medicaid 15 1915(i) state plan amendment, during the calendar year ending on December 31, 2022.
