- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 61-16.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the publication and distribution of water resource board meeting minutes.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 61-16.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 6 61-16.1-04. Minutes, books, and records.

7 The water resource board shall keep accurate minutes of its meetings and accurate records

8 and books of account, clearly setting out and reflecting the entire operation, management, and

- 9 business of the district. <u>The minutes of the meeting must be provided to the official newspaper</u>
- 10 of the county for publication or posted to the water resource board's website within ten days.
- 11 These books and records shall be kept at the principal office of the district or at such other
- 12 regularly maintained office or offices of the district as shall be designated by the board, with due
- 13 regard to the convenience of the district, its customers, and residents. The books and records

14 shall be open to public inspection during reasonable business hours.
