

# **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF A PAGE FOR A DAY**

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. Be on time. Hours are 8 a.m. until session adjourns.
2. Shadow a representative through committee hearings.
3. Page on the floor.
4. Deliver messages.
5. Run errands.

## **DRESS CODE**

1. Dress appropriately and conduct yourself in a professional manner.
2. Clothing that is revealing or offensive will not be allowed.
3. Attire:
  - a. Male - Sport coat, dress shirt and tie, dress pants, and dress shoes.
  - b. Female - Dress or a jacket and dress pants or skirt, and appropriate comfortable shoes.
  - c. No jeans; short skirts; crop tops, low-cut, see-through, or tight fitting tops or pants. No sandals, tennis shoes, or opened toes shoes are permitted.

## **REMINDERS**

- Address the Representatives and Senators as Representative/Senator and their last name.  
Example: Representative Doe; Senator Doe
- No eating or drinking food, candy, or gum on the floor.
- No hats/caps.
- No cellphone use on the floor or during a floor session.
- You will be assigned to a page. Visit with them about the session, bills, or ask them any questions you may have.
- Introduce yourself to your Representative or Senator and let them know you have arrived.
