<sup>1</sup> This amendment reduces the general fund appropriation for a grant to relocate the Pioneer Village from \$450,000 to \$150,000, provides for a transfer from the State Fair operating fund to the State Historical Society of \$100,000, and makes the transfer and appropriations contingent upon certification by the Director of the State Historical Society to the Director of the Office of Management and Budget that all Pioneer Village buildings located on the North Dakota state fairgrounds that are required to be removed to satisfy the court order have been removed by June 15, 2019.

<sup>1</sup> This amendment provides for a contingent general fund appropriation of \$150,000 to the State Historical Society for a grant to relocate Pioneer Village. The Senate provided \$450,000 from the general fund to relocate Pioneer Village and the House provided \$150,000 from the general fund and \$100,000 from the State Fair operating fund to relocate Pioneer Village. The appropriation is contingent upon certification by the Director of the State Historical Society to the Office of Management and Budget that all Pioneer Village buildings located on the North Dakota state fairgrounds that are required to be removed to satisfy the court order have been removed by June 15, 2019, the same as the House version. The Conference Committee added a provision that the State Fair must provide at least \$100,000 to the Ward County Historical Society relating to the Pioneer Village.
