HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE
HUMAN RESOURCES DIVISION
REGARDING HOUSE BILL NO. 1123
January 21, 1999**

Chairman Svedjan and members of the Human Resources Division of the House Appropriations Committee, my name is Yvonne Smith. I am the Deputy Director of the Department of Human Services. I appear on behalf of the department with respect to House Bill No. 1123.

The department requested introduction of this bill to repeal section 25-04-20. That section established the Westwood Park Assets Management Committee.

Senator Tallackson of the Senate Appropriations Committee has informed the department of that committee's intention to amend Senate Bill No. 2012, the department's appropriations bill, to repeal section 25-04-20. The Senate Committee's approach would provide for one less bill to be processed by the legislature. The matter will, in any event, come before this committee when it considers Senate Bill No. 2012.

For these reasons, the department recommends the committee give this bill a "do not pass."
