Good morning, Chairman Price, and members of the House Human Services Committee. My name is Corinne Bennett and I am the Administrator of Early Childhood Services for the Department of Human Services.

The Department requested introduction of House Bill 1142 because we believed the language to be deleted served no purpose. Within the last week, we have learned that the language allows the licensure of facilities that serve seven or fewer children, but which are not in the operator's home.

We must ask the committee to recommend a "do not pass" on this bill. We sincerely apologize for this mix-up. If the committee has any questions, I'll try to answer them.
