Minutes:

REP. M. KLEIN called the hearing to order, with all members present.

In favor:

REP. FROSETH, DISTRICT 6

Please see attached testimony.

REP. KROEBER asks how many licensor boards have more consumer people on it than one?

FROSETH replies that he is not sure.

REP. M. KLEIN replies that over a period of time these boards have been added to by the consumer side.

REP. METCALF asks about line 9, the elimination of the word personal, does the word of personal mean constant people over their shoulders? REP. FROSETH replies that the definition of constant personal means that there must be a journeyman or a master electrician to supervise at all times. REP. METCALF states that does not mean constant supervision to him.

REP. FROSETH states to the committee that is why he would like to take that language out, since it is such a gray area.

REP. KLEMIN asks about all the boards in section six, is that not a licensing board?

REP. FROSETH replies that he is not sure.

REP. HAAS states to the committee that ESPB is a licensing board.

REP. CLEARY asks why wouldn't all the other boards that license be included in this list?

REP. FROSETH replies that he does not know. REP. CLEARY asks about page 2, line 8, rebuilt things that can be included. So we can get these things built without any supervision?

REP. FROSETH replies that section 430921, standards for wiring electrical equipment. Comply with the rules of the board.

REP. DEVLIN asks about adding members from the public, diverse group on it already. What is the need to have 2 out of 3 members as to having nothing to do with the industry?

REP. FROSETH replies that there has been a trend nation wide, our state is better represented to the public if there are people from the public sector that are on these boards. There may be some amendments out there. It may go to a 7 member board. REP. DEVLIN asks about a rough in inspection done by a licensed electrician or by an inspector from the state board? REP. FROSETH replies that all work has to be supervised by a master electrician. REP. DEVLIN asks what are the credentials of the third party? REP. FROSETH replies that they have master electricians.

REP. KROEBER asks about elimination's. Staggering dates to replace them. Certainly the Governor has the right to appoint as the openings occur.

REP. HUNSKOR asks if a journeyman can do the work? REP. FROSETH replies yes.

REP. HUNSKOR has some concerns with the lowering of standards. REP. FROSETH does not believe that it would lower the standards.
