

Minutes:

REP. KLEMIN; Sponsor, introduced this bill to the committee at the request of the Bank of North Dakota. This is a technical change in the statute, this section of the law deals with the sale and leasing of agricultural real estate that has been acquired by the bank, through foreclosure or a deed where the property value is more than \$10,000. Both the Bank of North Dakota and the Board of University and School Lands are in agreement on this change.

RAY ZIMMERMANN; Bank of North Dakota, testified in support of this bill. See attached testimony.

SENATOR WANZEK; How is the policy held now with the current owner if they deed back property? Is this an issue you want to address in the change?

RAY ZIMMERMANN; The former owner has the first right to repurchase from these auction sales, which we advertise in the papers. The former owner at present has one hour to match the highest bid at a public auction sale. The former owner or members of his immediate family have

the right to match the highest bid within one hour after the sale has been closed. If that bid is not match the property goes to the highest bidder.

SENATOR WANZEK; Is that the current policy?

RAY ZIMMERMANN; That is the current policy, we differ a little bit. They have the consent from the former borrower and his immediate family. We interpret the statute that it is the former borrower and any member of his immediate family and not having the consent of the former borrower. They have to pay cash for the property.

The hearing was closed.

HOUSE BILL 1339

RAY ZIMMERMANN - BANK OF NORTH DAKOTA

The Bank of North Dakota is responsible for the preservation, management, and sale of acquired agricultural real estate.

BND is adhering to all statutes of the N.D.C.C. but would like to modify the policies of the Board of University and School Lands to create a policy more adaptable for the Bank of North Dakota. This policy is needed for BND to conduct business going forward with former borrowers, future purchasers, bank auditors, bank examiners, and attorneys. This modified policy will allow BND to conduct business in the Banking realm and in the agricultural sector to benefit both parties. BND is not holding these acquired properties as an investment, but the goal is to sell the property back to private individuals as soon as possible.

Our amendment would put these proposed policies to the discretion of the Industrial Commission.
