Jean Doll, Adm. of the Foster Care Program, Children & Family Services, Dept. of Human Services appeared in support with written testimony and suggests a house keeping amendment.

Discussion: Definition of "omitting material information" and what would fall into omitted material.

Krista Andrews, Attorney for Human Services appeared to answer further legal questions, such as the difference between the two words, "withhold or omitted", why one word instead of the other. Krista suggested using "intentionally withheld" instead of omitted.

Further discussion if any rules of the dept. are enforceable after they've gone through the Administrative Rules Process.

Krista Andrews replied "Yes certainly, we would wait until they were actually approved by the Administrative Rules Committee before we would be applying them.

It was also suggested to take out the word omitted on lines 10 and 12.
