Minutes: Senator John T. Traynor, Chairman, called the meeting to order. Roll call was taken and all committee members present. Sen. Traynor requested meeting starts with testimony on the bill:

Testimony in Support of HB 1146

Howard C. Anderson - Executive Director, Board of Pharmacy State of ND (meter .02) Read

Testimony - Attachment #1. Pharmacists treat all or our drugs the same due to compliance with the Federal Law. When law enforcement look at a particular drug and tries to site someone then it needs to be listed under ND's controlled substance act.

Buprenorphine - This drug has been scheduled before but now has gotten an increases usage of office treatment of narcotic addiction. Physicians in there office practice can use drug to detoxify patients that are addicted to narcotics. We have not previously had this ability. We used to only have Methadone Clinics (Mpls.)
