Rep. R. Metcalf: Introduced HB 1192 (see attached testimony and proposed amendments).

Page 1, line 11, overstrike "be equivalent to" and insert immediately thereafter "equal" and after "the" insert "market"

Page 1, line 12, after "maximum" insert "single" and replace "value" with "amount allowed"

Page 1, after line 12, insert:

"SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure."
