Minutes: Senator John T. Traynor, Chairman, called the meeting to order. Roll call was taken and all committee members present. Sen. Traynor requested meeting starts with testimony on the bill:

Testimony in Support of HB 1213

Rep. Delmore - Dist. 43, Introduced Bill. (Meter 8.7) Last session we did a laundry lists to make private the telephone numbers and home addresses of several people dealing with law enforcement and so on. We indiscriminately left out the juvenile court officers. There job in dealing with some of our most rambunctious adolescence can lead to a number of problems with both addresses-things happening to there properties, as well as phone calls. A constituent from Grand Forks, working with these kids, requested of me to be added to the laundry list we already have.

Sen. Lyson discussed an amendment with Jack Colby. (meter 10).

Sen. Dever asked who all is included as a juvenile court officer on the list. (meter 10.3).

Referred to the bill last session and what this bill would add the juvenile court officers- Sen. Trenbeath presumed juvenile supervisors and his probation officers... employees in correctional facilities are already included. Being that they are confidential what is the legality if someone were to give out a number for an invitation to a social event. That is an interesting question.

Sen. Trenbeath commented that when a number is given out to a friend do you not waive the confidentiality by making it public yourself.

Mary Kay Kelsh - Assistant Attorney General Technical Assistant. Did not find juvenile court officer defined in code. Sponsor of bill meant juvenile supervisors, probation officers, or people who worked in juvenile court offices.

Sen. Traynor questioned the district court acts also as the juvenile courts? The district courts are already protected.

Discussed amendment to include after court "supervisors and probation".
