**CHAIRMAN COOK** opened the hearing on HB 1288 relating to the compensation of members of a board of park commissioners.

**REPRESENTATIVE JIM KASPER**, District 46, Fargo, ND introduced HB 1288. It is a bill to correct a part of the statute of the State of North Dakota that was overlooked many years ago where park board commissioners who are elected officials, could not determine their own destiny when it comes to their salary as far as whether they receive any and how much. Current statute requires the city commissions of the various areas that have park districts to give the blessing to any salaries and any salary increases. What this bill would do is simply require the park board commissioners to set and determine their own salary with public hearings and all the procedures
