Explanation or reason for introduction of bill/resolution:

Relating to licenses to hunt big game without charge and big game hunting licenses for nonresident landowners; and relating to licenses to hunt big game and governor's proclamations concerning hunting.

Minutes:

Vice Chairman Damschen: opened the hearing on HB 1430.

Rep. Porter, Dist. 34: HB 1430 looks at the disparity between the different licenses and processes for a gratis tag in ND. It was apparent we have different requirements and guidelines for all species of big game. We have elk, special elk, moose, antelope. I want to make sure the basic rules of the permitting process were the same mainly going to the entity situation, where we allow legal entities to apply for certain licenses, and legal entities not able to apply for others. My hope was to clean this up and make it into one. Then into the fall the moose scenario started popping up and different individuals contacting myself, Rep. Anderson, Rep. Johnson, talking about the differences in the moose license. In regards to entities is in HB 1430. Not in there is the multiple tags from a single individual or entity. As we head to crossover, we'll hope to sit down in a subcommittee and then a committee as a whole, and make the determinations on how we want the permits and system to look.

Rep. Porter: Does the department have mule deer numbers available or do we need to get that.

Rep Heinert: Don't have them.
