

GENERAL FUND DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR UTILITY AND FUEL COSTS

This memorandum provides information requested at the June 14, 2006, Bismarck meeting on general fund deficiency appropriations provided to state agencies and institutions for utility and fuel costs by the 1985 through 2005 Legislative Assemblies. Each of the deficiency appropriations were emergency
