

NOTICE OF INTENT TO
AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Board of Counselor Examiners will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code title 97 January 3, 2018, 11:30 am, at the Peace Garden Room in the North Dakota State Capitol, 600 E. Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND 58505. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to clarify and update the laws regarding the practice of counselors in the State of North Dakota. The proposed amendments address licensing requirements and the code of ethics. The proposed rulemaking implements bill number 2033, enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning supervision requirements for licensure. The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the Board's office at 2112 10th Avenue SE, Mandan, ND 58554. Written or oral comments on the proposed rules sent to the above address or telephone number and received January 13, 2018, will be fully considered.
