**Item Description**

**Directory fees** - Section 2 of House Bill No. 1005 provides legislative intent that the Indian Affairs Commission establish a fee to recover all or a portion of its costs related to printing and distributing its directory.

**Budget section report** - Section 14 of House Bill No. 1015 requires the Industrial Commission and the Indian Affairs Commission to report to the Budget Section on the status of home mortgage finance programs of the Housing Finance Agency available within Indian reservations located in North Dakota.

**Status/Result**

The Indian Affairs Commission has not determined a fee plan for its directories or when the directories will be updated.

A representative of the Indian Affairs Commission anticipates reporting to the June 2000 meeting of the Budget Section.
