

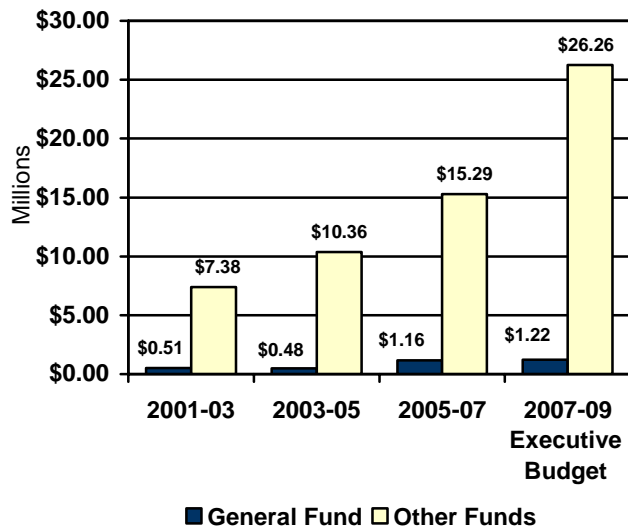

A total of 7.10 FTE positions were removed pursuant to this section and reported to the Office of Management and Budget.

**Other Sections in Bill**

Section 4 of House Bill No. 1020 provides that, in addition to the amount appropriated as other funds, any other income received from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other sources received by the Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute, is appropriated for the purposes designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation for the 2007-09 biennium.

Section 6 of House Bill No. 1020 authorizes the State Board of Higher Education to adjust or increase FTE positions for the Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute and report any adjustments to the Office of Management and Budget.

Section 7 of House Bill No. 1020 authorizes the carryover of any unexpended general fund appropriation and excess income received by the Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute to the 2009-11 biennium.

Section 8 of House Bill No. 1020 provides that the \$5.5 million authorized for the Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute building is an emergency measure.
