


²The Main Research Center allocated \$66,000 of general fund appropriation to North Dakota State University Extension Service for critical needs. Section 5 of Senate Bill No. 2020 (2005) authorizes that upon approval of the State Board of Agricultural Research and Education and appropriate branch research directors, the director of the Main Research Center may transfer appropriation authority within the North Dakota State University Extension Service, Northern Crops Institute, Main Research Center, and branch research centers.

Other Sections in Bill

Section 4 of House Bill No. 1020 provides that, in addition to the amount appropriated as other funds, any other income received from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other sources received by the NDSU Extension Service is appropriated for the purpose designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation for the 2007-09 biennium.

Section 5 of House Bill No. 1020 authorizes the transfer of appropriation authority between the Main Research Center, the branch research centers, NDSU Extension Service, and Northern Crops Institute.

Section 6 of House Bill No. 1020 authorizes the State Board of Higher Education to adjust or increase full-time equivalent positions for the NDSU Extension Service and report any adjustments to the Office of Management and Budget.

Section 7 of House Bill No. 1020 authorizes the carryover of any unexpended general fund appropriation and excess income received by the NDSU Extension Service.
