**Senate Bill No. 2103 - Attorney General - Senate Action**

This bill provides a \$500,000 special funds appropriation from the insurance regulatory trust fund to the Attorney General for reimbursing health care providers for the cost of performing forensic medical examinations on alleged victims of criminal sexual conduct. This bill reduces general fund revenues by \$500,000 by reducing the amount that would otherwise be transferred from the insurance regulatory trust fund.

**Senate Bill No. 2103 - Attorney General - House Action**
