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**Senate Bill No. 2326 - DHS - Program and Policy - Senate Action**

This bill appropriates \$2,733,767, of which \$1,059,932 is from the general fund and \$1,673,835 is from special funds, to the Department of Human Services for establishing and implementing a Medicaid buy-in program for families of children with disabilities and for the Medicaid waiver to provide in-home services to children with extraordinary medical needs. The department is authorized 1 FTE position for these programs.
