<sup>1</sup> This amendment reduces funding for a grant to the Parks and Recreation Department for the Grahams Island State Park roadway project by \$300,000 to provide total grant funding of \$100,000.

<sup>2</sup> This amendment increases the amount of funding to be provided to the Agriculture Commissioner for the Wildlife Services program to provide a total of \$868,800.

A section is added to appropriate \$200,000 from the game and fish fund to the Game and Fish Department for the remainder of the 2009-11 biennium to be provided to the Agriculture Commissioner for the Wildlife Services program. Legislative intent is included in the section, and the section is declared to be an emergency measure.

<sup>2</sup> Funding of \$300,000 removed by the Senate for the Grahams Island State Park road project is restored to provide total grant funding of \$400,000 for the project.

<sup>3</sup> The land habitat and deer depredation line item is increased due to anticipated additional federal funding for hunting access programs and greater than anticipated requests for deer depredation assistance. The funding is declared to be an emergency measure.

<sup>4</sup> Funding provided to the Agriculture Department from the game and fish fund for wildlife depredation purposes is reduced from \$868,800 to \$400,000.

This amendment also:

- Provides that funding for Missouri River law enforcement activities may be used for salaries and operating expenses for department employees coordinating or performing Missouri River law enforcement activities and for grants to local law enforcement agencies performing Missouri River law enforcement activities. The funding may not be used to purchase equipment with a cost of \$3,000 or more.
- Provides for a Legislative Management study of the United States Department of Agriculture Wildlife Services program.

This amendment also adds a section to provide that funding for Missouri River law enforcement activities may be used for salaries and operating expenses for department employees coordinating or performing Missouri River law enforcement activities and for grants to local law enforcement agencies performing Missouri River law enforcement activities. The funding may not be used to purchase equipment with a cost of \$3,000 or more.
