7-06-01-01. Weed control officer's certification.

Repealed effective April 1, 2010.

7-06-01-02. Noxious weeds listed.

Weeds declared noxious shall be confined to weeds that are difficult to control, easily spread, and injurious to public health, crops, livestock, land, or other property. The following weeds have been declared noxious for the purpose of North Dakota Century Code chapter 63-01.1:

1. Absinth wormwood (*Artemisia absinthium* L.).
2. Canada thistle (*Cirsium arvense* (L.) Scop.).
3. Dalmatian toadflax (*Linaria dalmatica*).
4. Diffuse knapweed (*Centaurea diffusa* Lam.).
5. Houndstongue (*Cynoglossum officinale*).
6. Leafy spurge (*Euphorbia esula* L.).
7. Musk thistle (*Carduus nutans* L.).
8. Purple loosestrife (*Lythrum salicaria* L., *Lythrum virgatum* L., and all cultivars).
9. Russian knapweed (*Rhaponticum repens*).
10. Saltcedar (*Tamarix spp.*).
11. Spotted knapweed (*Centaurea stoebe*).
12. Yellow toadflax (*Linaria vulgaris*).
