FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota State Board of Funeral Service will hold a public hearing to address proposed **amendments to** N.D. Admin. Code 25-02-02-02 and 25-05-01-10 at 10:00am on Friday, March 31, 2023, at 213 2nd Ave SW, Rugby, North Dakota. The purpose of the proposed **amendments to section 25-02-02-02** is clarify and update rules related to licensure qualifications and crematory requirements.

The proposed amendment to 25-02-02-02 addresses experience of reciprocal license holders. The proposed amendment to 25-05-01-10 addresses cremation of animals in crematoriums.

The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the ND State Board of Funeral Service.
